## Carter Synergy Supports Employee Voluntary Work

Carter Synergy is pleased to support Building Services Manager, Nick Freeman, who is based at our Birmingham office in his work as a Community First Responder.



Community First Responders (CFRs) attend 999 ambulance calls in their local area, particularly where they can arrive before the professional Ambulance Service resource and are fully trained to nationally recognized standards to render aid to the public in any emergency situation.

Nick has been a CFR for 8 years and is given use of his company vehicle to respond (requiring special insurance arrangements) – he has also rendered aid at road accidents enroute to work and also successfully resuscitated a member of the public who was in cardiac arrest whilst attending a client meeting in Peterborough.

As well as being an active responder within his community, Nick is also a qualified Trainer and trains new CFRs for West Midlands Ambulance Service (WMAS) and has also trained Carter Synergy's own First Aiders in use of Automated External Defibrillators – Carter Synergy have invested in AEDs for each office location.

In November 2015 Nick received a Distinguished Service Award from WMAS's Chief Officer for his work as a CFR and Carter Synergy are proud to be able to support this lifesaving work.
